21/069 CHAIRMANS ANNOUNCEMENT

Councillor Laughlin recorded formally that the Derbyshire Dales Call for Sites Consultation May 2021 had started and the PC should look at a strategy for dealing with it. Councillor Laughlin went to Sycamore Way following concerns about riding bikes etc raised at the last meeting. There appears to be no change to the site. The road is still unadopted and most houses are now complete. The Avant site appears to be poorly maintained. A parishioner had raised concerns about a path not joining up with other developments. Cllr Laughlin was unable to locate the footpath in a site visit. Cllr Cragg will discuss with complainant. The Clerk has followed this up with DDDC/Councillor M Morley.

21/071 FLOODING/STW UPDATE

No update received from STW. The Cameron site water retention ponds appear to be working but concerns were raised that they need fencing off as well as the Miller Homes site one. The Miller site looks to be maturing nicely. The Avant site requires some grounds maintenance.

21/072 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN UPDATE

Final updates to the plan had been submitted to DDDC. The plan goes to DDDC Committee on the 18 June for ratification.

21/073 INTERNAL AUDIT 2020/2021

The internal audit had been received and was noted.

21/074 BRAILSFORD INSTITUTE S106 MONIES

Councillor Laughlin had been unable to attend the last meeting and the proposed plans have not been received. The Institute are still looking at redevelopment. The Pre-school had raised issues with the cleaning. The Parish Council raised concerns about the ground's maintenance including overgrown hedge at the drive exit. It was agreed that it is important that an additional person attends the Institute meeting and this would be followed up with Councillor Tice. It was agreed to ask the Institute Chair to attend a PC meeting to provide an update. The next Institute meeting is 23 June which Councillor Laughlin may not be able to attend.
